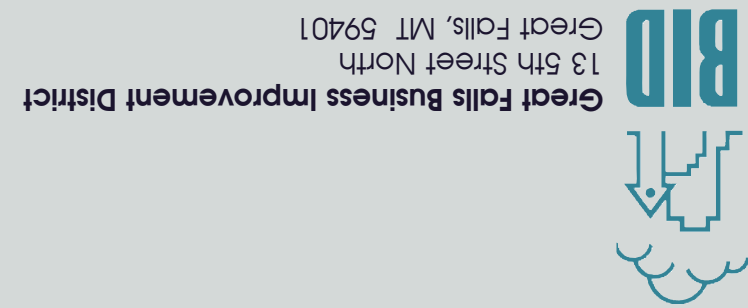

The BID will Provide the following services within its designated boundaries:

DOWNTOWN PROPERTY INVESTMENTS

Our grant programs financially assist both property owners & businesses in the areas of permanent improvements to the downtown business district and in the development of residential properties. We will continue with these programs of assistance with the goal of evaluating how our dollars are best spent and maximizing their effect in the development of the properties located within the BID. In utilizing this program we hope to continue to attract new business and residents to the downtown area.

- The BID's grant programs are continually evolving to meet the needs of our property & business owners.
- The BID will utilize additional grant sources to supplement available funding.

UNIFYING ENTITIES

Our goal is to take the lead in joining with other development organizations so that we may make a greater impact in the areas of:

- **Marketing**—working together to develop a comprehensive marketing program for Great Falls.
- **Communication**—develop a more efficient system of communication with our property owners, business owners, residents and other development organizations utilizing e-mails, our web-site and personal contact.
- **Volunteers**—establish a pool of volunteers as a resource for events and special projects who are also available to act as advocates for Great Falls.

BEAUTIFICATION

The BID will continue its efforts in ongoing tree maintenance, flowers, garbage removal and other areas of importance.

- **Tree & flower maintenance**—Maintain the beauty of our downtown.

- **Garbage Removal**—Working continuously on removal of garbage within the BID.
- **Sidewalk Cleaning/Snow Removal**—Establish a program where the BID works with business & property owners to improve our sidewalk areas for our downtown guests.
- **Downtown Park Project**—Working with property & business owners to assist in the fruition of this project.

BUSINESS INCUBATOR

The BID is taking over management of the Business Incubator this year. We continue to explore the best options for management of the incubator, working toward the success of this valuable downtown project.

The incubator is available to those businesses just getting started that need public office space, and a low dollar lease in a professional setting.

A business incubator allows a start-up company up to a two-year lease to get your business off the ground. After one year your business will be evaluated as to the direction it is taking. When you are ready to venture out on your own, the BID will help you find retail or office space downtown in Great Falls.

The incubator currently has office spaces available.

The BID continues to support our local community in many other ways, including, but not limited to:

- Support of the Urban Art Project.
- Support of the Downtown Great Falls Association in all of its endeavors.
- Support of the Parking Commission in its efforts of improving the downtown.
- Installation of holiday lighting in the downtown trees.
- Other projects as presented and decided upon by the Board.
